Improving your access via road and rail to Leeds Bradford Airport



Leeds Bradford Airport is one of the UK's fastest growing airports, handling over 4 million passengers a year with the Department for Transport forecasting passengers to reach 7.1 million by 2030 and approximately 9 million by 2050.

Connecting Leeds and West Yorkshire Combined Authority have plans to improve access issues to the airport. These are:

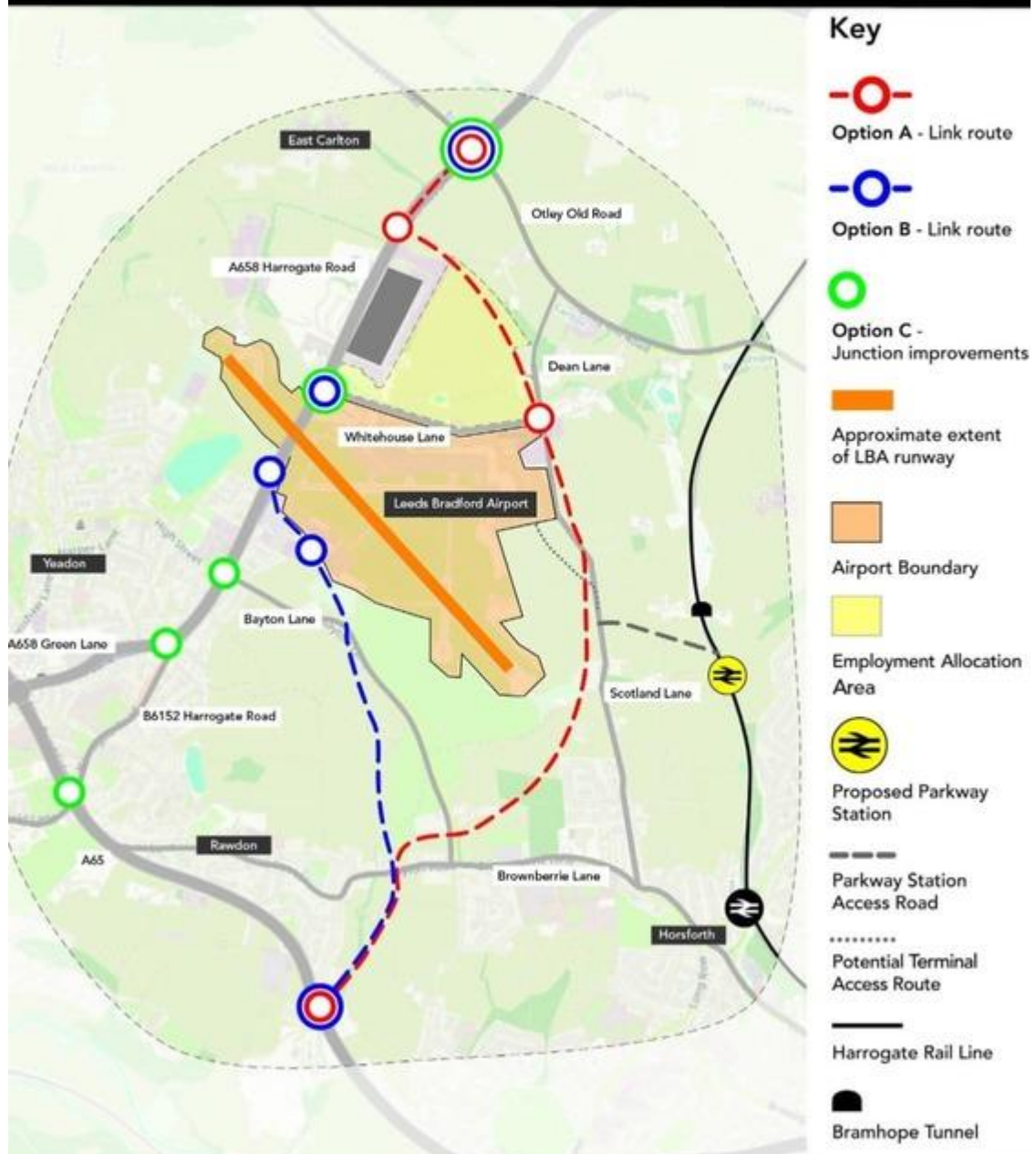


Rail alone is not the option
