Circular From West Park Residents Association

Drop-In Session – Modified Proposals for the Lawnswood Junction

You are invited to turn up any time between 5pm to 8pm on Thursday, 13-09-2018 at the [YMCA, Otley Road, LS16 6HQ](#).

The original proposals for the junction have been revised following the earlier six-week public consultation period. This public drop-in session is intended especially for local residents who may be directly impacted by the Lawnswood junction improvement scheme.

Members of the *Connecting Leeds* team from Leeds City Council will be available to talk through the plans and respond to questions.

Changes to the Lawnswood junction will affect access to properties and on-street parking along:

- The Outer Ring Road (A6120) close to the Lawnswood junction
- Woodlands Court
- Otley Road between the Outer Ring Road and Lawnswood Cemetery
- Grangewood Gardens
- The Grange Road
- Lawnswood Gardens
- Otley Old Road between the YMCA entrance and Otley Road.

We are advised by the Council that: "*This meeting will focus only on the proposals for Lawnswood and Otley Old Road. Decisions will be made in the coming months as to how the proposals presented during the recent consultation for the rest of the Adel to Leeds route along the A660 will progress. If any of the proposals are to progress, further consultation will be required in the New Year*".

Highway Improvements – Junction of Spen Lane & Spen Road

The following is an extract from a letter sent to residents who may be directly affected by the above work:

"As part of our highway improvement programme we intend to carry out works at the above location. The works will consist of the installation of a pedestrian island on Spen Lane and 2 kerblines buildouts on Spen Road.

The works are planned to commence Tuesday 28th August and will be completed in approximately 11 working days. From Tuesday 28th August for approximately 1 week there will be two-way signals on Spen Lane and we will also be utilizing the road closure currently in place for the ongoing gas works".
