(TRAFFIC REGULATION) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS)
(NO.W40) ORDER
2009**

**ANCASTER ROAD/GLEN ROAD AREAS
LEEDS
TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT MEASURES**

Leeds City Council proposes to make the above Order under its powers contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to introduce:-

1. no waiting at any time on sections of Ancaster Road, Back Welburn Avenue, Caythorpe Road, Church Wood Avenue, Darnley Road, Glen Road, Harrowby Road, Hollin Drive, Hollin Lane, Kepstorn Road, Northolme Avenue, the A660 Otley Road, Spen Road, Weetwood Avenue, Weetwood Lane, Welburn Avenue, Welburn Drive and Welburn Grove;
2. no waiting between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm on Monday to Friday inclusive on sections of Weetwood Avenue and Weetwood Lane;
3. waiting limited to 2 hours with no return within 2 hours between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive on sections of Kepstorn Road and Welburn Grove ;
4. waiting limited to 2 hours with no return within 2 hours between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Saturday inclusive (except for permit holders) on sections of Northolme Avenue, and Welburn Avenue;
5. residents only permit parking between 8.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Friday inclusive on the full lengths of Church Wood Mount, Church Wood Road, Drummond Court, and Hollins Gardens and on sections of Church Wood Avenue, Drummond Avenue and Drummond Road;
6. residents only permit parking between 10.00 am and 6.00 pm on Monday to Friday inclusive on the full lengths of Ancaster Crescent, Ancaster View, Harrowby Crescent, Helmsley Drive, Helmsley Road, Northolme Avenue and Northolme Crescent and on sections of Ancaster Road, Caythorpe Road, Harrowby Road, Welburn Avenue and Welburn Drive;

Full details of the proposals in the form of a draft Order together with a plan showing the affected sections of highway and a statement of reasons for making the Order may be examined during normal office hours at the Legal, Licensing & Registration Reception Desk, 1st Floor, St. George House, Great George Street, Leeds 1 and at Headingley Library, North Lane, Leeds 6.
